#### **SHORT HISTORY OF SLUK**

The Croatian meeting place of puppeteers and puppet theatres -SLUK – a theatre festival dedicated exclusively to the art of puppetry, that is, the art of puppetry in Croatia. The first SLUK was held in Opatija in 1969 as a result of a festival stage in Šibenik, International Puppet Theatre Festival (PIF) and "Opatija Autumns – Puppets for Children and Adults." The way for the organisational and artistic outline of the future biennial festival was paved in Osijek in 1977 when SLUK found its place in the sun in the organisation of the Children's Theatre and several cultural institutions from Osijek. Since then, SLUK has been a competitive festival and therefore focused on the artistic scope of the selected performances. The shows are performed on different stages on which, besides the local ones, the foreign ensembles also perform. Having been held in Osijek for a long period of time, SLUK was held in Zadar in 1991 and that was the last meeting in the former country. Since the first SLUK in the independent Croatia in 1993 until now, the meeting has been taking place in Osijek, even though one meeting was organised in Split and one in Zadar. The reason for this is the construction of the new theatre facilities in Split and Zadar. By changing the regulations, the festival has obtained a possibility to be organised in various Croatian towns, therefore, it was held again in Zadar in 2017, and this year the puppeteers are gathering in Osijek. The festival has gone through different organisational changes and has become the meeting point and showcase of the best puppet achievements in the country.

#### About the performance:

This combination of puppetry and acting performance blends elements of object theatre, mask and storytelling. We go back to the original 19th century story by E.T.A. Hoffman in which the main character, a little girl Marica, influenced by many stories she had heard and her vivid imagination, slips into the realm of dreams, puppets, tales of long ago. Still, her world doesn't consist only of glittering lights and chocolate scent, but it is a bit twisted, out of place – helped by her vivid imagination and dreams, Marica sees things differently than others. In her world, Christmas presents are battling against mice from traditional tales, and a family friend Mr Drosselmeier becomes a wizard, an omniscient storyteller, a great mind that controls the universe. Boundaries between dream and reality are blurred, a tale becomes a reality, and a reality is part of a tale, all the while blending theatre and puppet magic with the one of Christmas. The interplay of light and shadow in this "Nutcracker" creates an illusion – the one which can, under the cloak of night and theatre, overwhelm, enchant, delight and amaze us!

#### About the perfomance:

Ero s onoga svijeta / Ero the Joker is the most famous work of a Croatian composer Jakov Gotovac and a librettist Milan Begović. The director Krešimir Dolenčić is an author of a few productions of "Ero" on stages of modern Croatian theatre history, but also of a performance which has been continually performed in Croatian National Theatre in Zagreb in the last 31 years. This puppet Ero is an adaptation of the most popular musical motifs from the opera, created by a master composer and conductor Mladen Tarbuk which uses a simple storyline of a funny local tale. The wittiness of the wonderful lyrics from the libretto, which are also spoken in this production, has been preserved in an adaptation by a dramaturg Ana Tonković. Patricia Alejandra Marina Aguera is in charge of the visual design of the performance which successfully, like the music, follows the folklore elements, emphasising comedy which is carved into the opera itself.

The main character is Mića, a man who is looking for a girl to marry. His mother advises him to pretend to be poor, like Ero the Joker, because he wants to be certain that his chosen one Đula honestly loves him. The comedy plot and superb music, inspired by the traditions of Dalmatian hinterland will surely intrigue even the youngest audience. We believe that the puppet Ero the Joker will gain young theatre audience, encourage awareness of the value of local artistic legacy and entertain spectators of all generations.



#### About the performance:

"Duuugodan Zubić vile" / "A Looongish Day of the Tooth Fairy" is a performance for children which intertwines a fantastic world of Zvonka, a tooth fairy, and her elves with the world of one, at a glance, ordinary family on the Earth. The emphasis is on twisted priorities of a modern world in which there is no time for anything that doesn't involve profit. The plot centres on a boy Marko, who triggers an alarming situation in the tooth fairy's world when he loses his last tooth and which leads to a discussion about growing up, parents, technology and smile, showing that a child's smile is still (and forever) brighter than any screen.

Combining shadow theatre and puppets, this show opens the world of imagination that is deeply rooted in serious and important issues – issues of a happy childhood and an honest smile and the importance of these things being genuine. Happy and sincere, things that matter.

#### About the performance:

Being inspired by her surroundings, Ria Trdin has written a didactic fairy tale for her daughter vividly named "Zlogrba"/ "Evilhunch". When the daughter grew up, she dusted off her old fairy tale and decided to share it with other children. The values described in the tale haven't faded, nor they ever will.

And therefore...The day has come, so special for Evilhunch. The day when the bloody moon is shining, and the witch can become young and beautiful. Only a potion needs to be made and a child put into it. Thinking that it's so easy to cook a child, Evilhunch made a fatal error. A little girl Lovorka has changed the foul witch completely with her cheerfulness and kind heart. 

The book Lutkarska čuda svijeta/ Puppets' Wonders of the World gives a systematic overview of the world puppetry. Setting off across the world of puppets, the author starts where everything had probably begun – in Asia, then moves on to Africa, America and Australia, introducing us to various, sometimes conflicting, perspectives on puppetry and a puppet. By doing so, not only does she introduce us to the basic characteristics of puppetry in particular surroundings, but also to religious, philosophical, social and other ideas that make their core, substantially different from our European point of view. And that is one of the great values of this book – highlighting the breadth, richness and diversity of puppetry which, on the other hand, draws attention to the diversity of the world that encompasses us.



#### About the lecture:

Modern thermoplastic materials are often an excellent addition to traditional materials which are used for puppet making. They can also be applied for the creation of tiny details and for larger construction of puppets or stage props. Their advantages include simplicity and speed of use, a possibility of combining with other materials, strength and non-toxicity. In short, these materials can be heated, welded and moulded, and after cooling they retain shape or bond – until the next heating. During this introductory workshop, we will show numerous examples how we, as well as other artists, use thermoplastics in our work. Participants will have the chance to try different thermoplastic materials themselves. From that moment – everything is in the hands of your imagination!

#### About the performance:

Creating coincidences

Scavenging among the shards of our cast's childhood memories - Damir's, Andreja's, Tilen's, Petra's and David's, we processed them, transformed and created a combination of poetic, but in the same time, humorous, grotesque and sentimental images styled as the thematic – musical cabaret. Each private confession intertwines in a funny way with the history of Rijeka, its people, streets, as well as cultural or language particularities. Out of nothing, a musical - theatre composition arises in front of a spectator, followed by live music, dynamic alterations of scenery and lights, sophisticated animation and charismatic actors. The composition addresses a young and an elderly spectator on different levels with many flashes (remembrances). The spectator is completely involved in the game, because one can personally choose the next chocolatina that hides a new episode from the life of one of our protagonists. Making the show was quite a challenge that involved exploring themes, examination of materials, but, more than anything, a teamwork of talented actors and animators of a puppet theatre from Rijeka. We hope that a boy who had been daydreaming on a branch of his grandma's cherry tree or, yet, a little inventress will take you to the surreal world of children.
